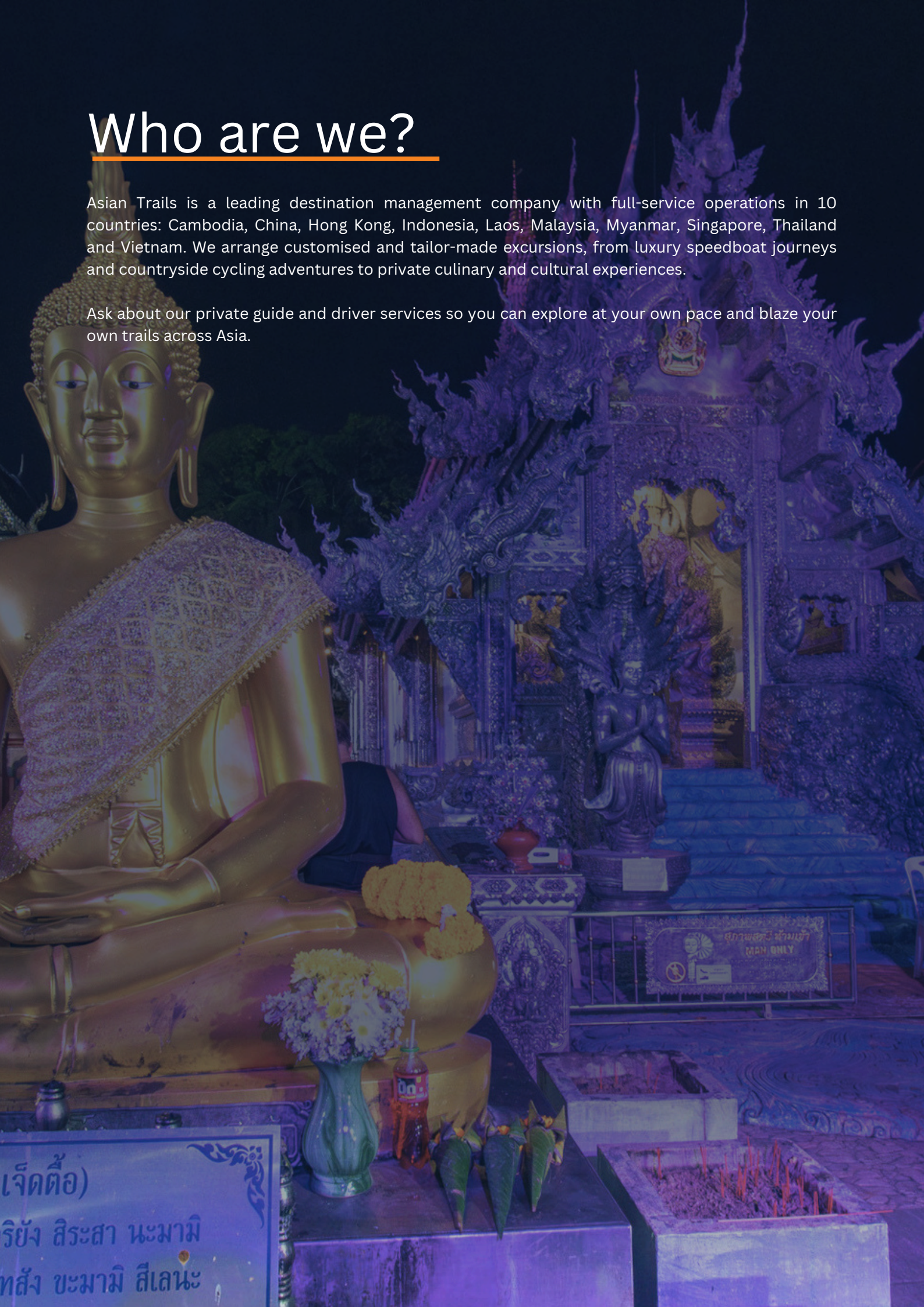

HALF DAY CITY AND TEMPLES WITH WAROROT MARKET

Operates daily from 8.30 am to 1.30 pm.

Chiang Mai is a city steeped in history with a unique culture defined more than 300 temples. Discover revered landmarks, beginning with Wat Chiang Man, the city's oldest temple, founded by King Mengrai in 1296. Admire classic Lanna architecture at Wat Chedi Luang and the striking Wat Sri Suphan, adorned with silver, nickel, and aluminium by local silversmiths. Conclude the tour at the lively Warorot Market, where you can browse a variety of local goods and products.

HALF DAY CITY AND TEMPLES WITH DOI SUTHEP

Operates daily from 8.30 am to 1 pm.

Explore Chiang Mai's sacred sites, beginning with a winding journey up the mountain to Wat Phra That Doi Suthep. Perched over 1,000 metres above sea level, it offers spectacular views over the city. Continue to Warorot Market, the city's largest market, where you'll find everything from household items to delicious local food and snacks. Proceed to Wat Phra Singh, a revered pilgrimage site, and visit Wat Chedi Luang, home to a striking Lanna-style pagoda.

PRIVATE HALF DAY LAMPHUN AND HARIPHUNCHAI

Operates daily from 8.30 am to 1.30 pm.

Travel approximately 30 kilometres south of Chiang Mai to explore the historic city of Lamphun. This quiet provincial town offers a glimpse of traditional life, where centuries of heritage have been preserved. The tour includes a visit to one of the oldest and most important temples in the region, Wat Phra That Hariphunchai, which houses the world's largest bronze gong. The temple complex also serves as a centre for monastic education.

PRIVATE FULL DAY DOI INTHANON

PRIVATE HALF DAY THAI URBAN TOUR AND WIANG KUM KAM

Explore the ancient ruins by horse-drawn carriage and enjoy a 45-minute ride on a traditional 'Scorpion Tail' boat along the Mae Ping River.

PRIVATE HALF DAY HMONG DOI PUI VILLAGE AND DOI SUTHEP

Departs at 6.30 am. Tour duration: 5 hours.

Visit Wat Phra That Doi Suthep, one of Chiang Mai's most sacred temples. Perched more than 1,000 metres above sea level, it offers spectacular views over the city and features distinctive Lanna-style murals. Continue to the Hmong village of Doi Pui to experience the community's way of life and learn about their colourful traditional dress.

KHANTOKE DINNER AND SHOW AT OLD CHIANG MAI CULTURAL CENTRE

Departs at 7 pm. Tour duration: 3.5 hours.

Enjoy a Northern Thai Khantoke dinner, accompanied by dance and music. A selection of dishes is served sharing-style in small bowls, known as 'khan', on a low table called 'toke'. The dishes reflect a blend of neighbouring cuisines, including sticky rice from Laos, curries from Myanmar, and rice noodles from China. Traditional performances include the ramwong circle dance and the ram dab sword dance.

PRIVATE CHIANG MAI NIGHT SAFARI

Get up close and personal with wildlife at the Chiang Mai Night Safari. Spanning a vast area, the park offers two trails for nocturnal viewing. Take the tram at around 7:45 pm to the Savannah Safari Zone, a popular area for spotting spotted hyenas, cheetahs, wildebeest, giraffes, yaks, and barasingha. At around 8:30 pm, continue to the Predator Prowl Zone, where you may encounter lions, wolves, black bears, foxes, and more.

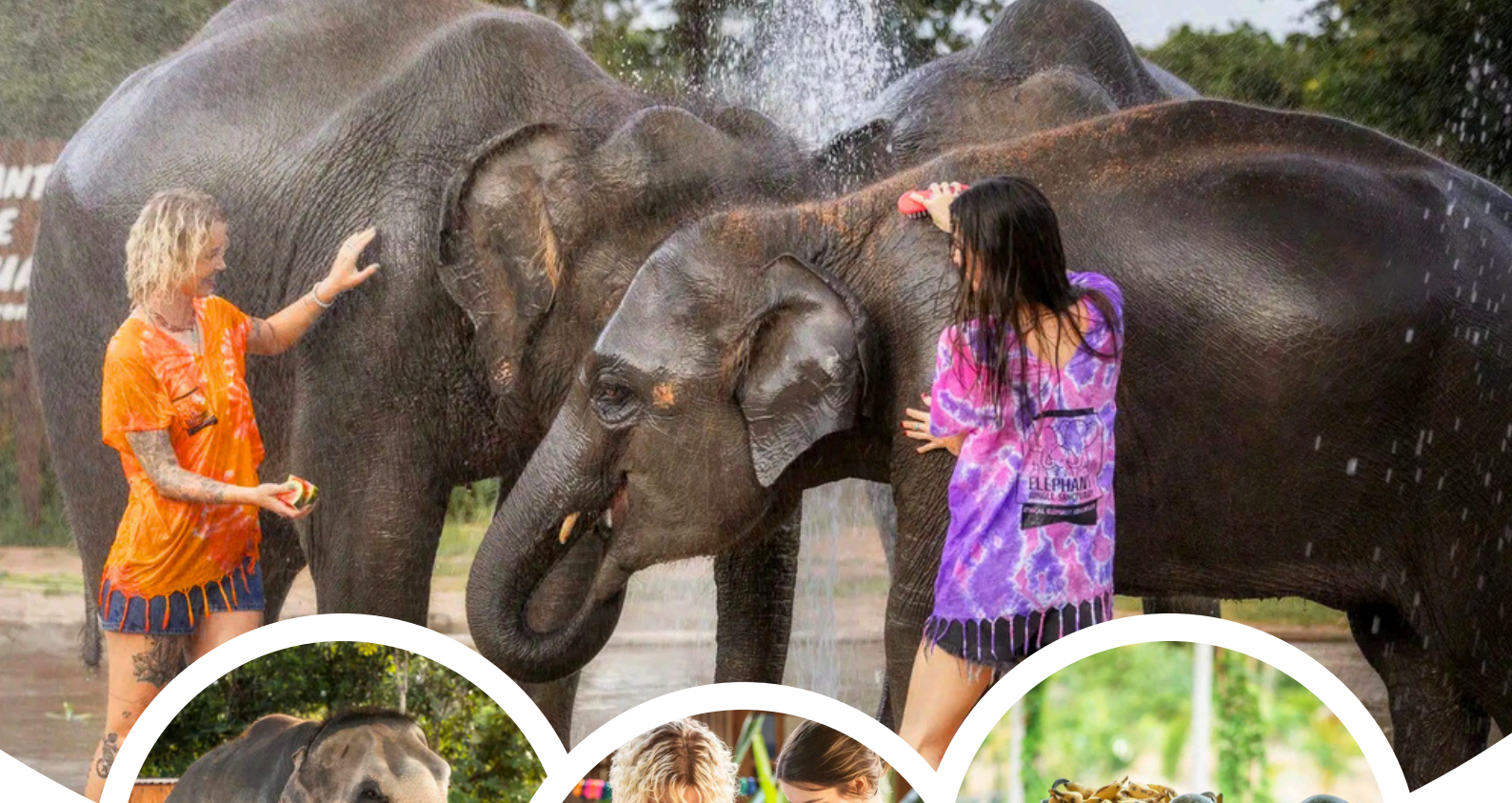
